An acclaimed design that promotes the partnership of the GP practice and Community Services which occupy it. Framed views of the garden and pond, and the curved focal reception counter engender a sense of wellbeing to both staff and patients. As well as providing effective primary healthcare to meet the needs of the local community, the Fairfield Health Centre is an enrichment of this leafy suburban site.
